Course Overview: Mål for emnet er å gi kunnskap om innovasjon og entreprenørskap som fenomen, anvendelse av Lean metoden, samt gi god trening i praktisk arbeid gjennom tverrfaglige prosjekter. Det legges opp til "flipped classroom" hvor studentene jobber med pensum og reflekterer rundt teorier gjennom workshops. Studentene må selv koble teori og egen praksis. Mye av læringen vil oppstå som følge av de prosessene studentene selv skaper. Den timeplanlagte undervisningen legges opp med forelesninger, workshops og diskusjoner i klassen. Forelesninger og inspirasjonsforedrag legger grunnlaget for teamkontrakt, problemavklaring og idegenerering. Gruppene jobber kontinuerlig med sitt prosjekt gjennom hele semesteret. Veileder blir tildelt. Rapportering og muntlige presentasjoner.
